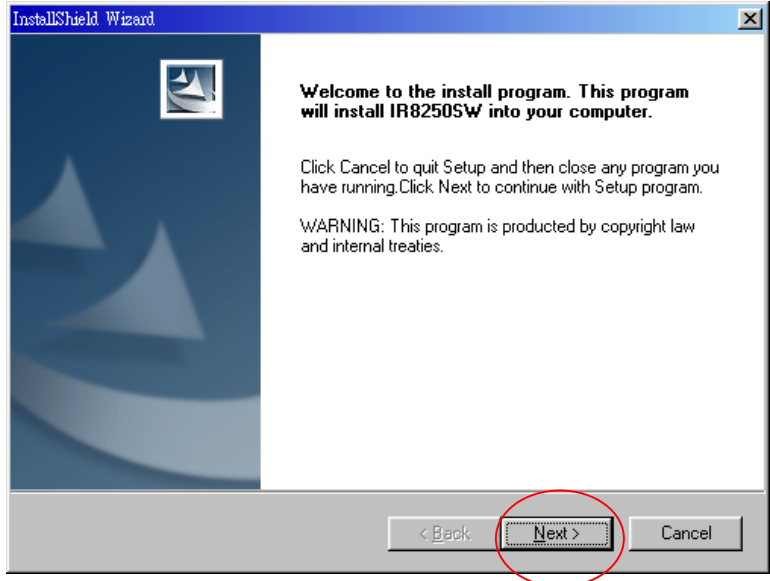

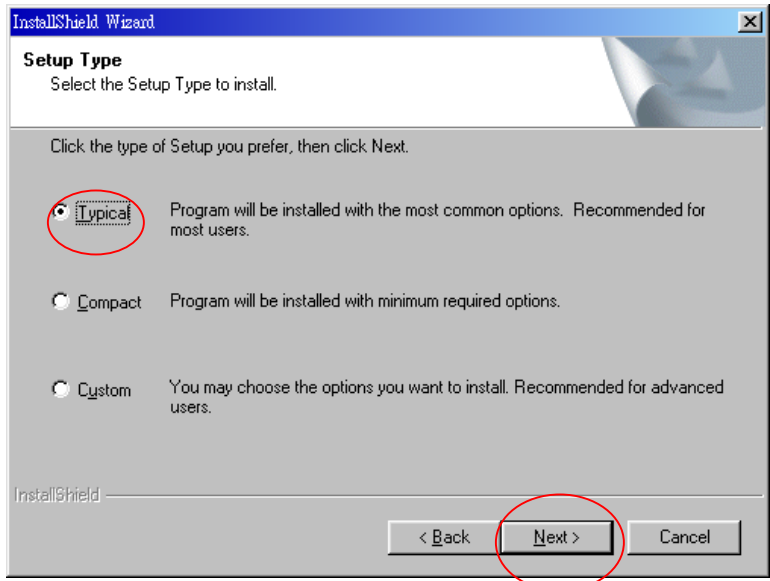
Following is the installation instruction for ACTiSYS ACT-IR8250SW under Windows 2000.

Note: This program supports **Windows 98/Me/2000/NT/XP**.

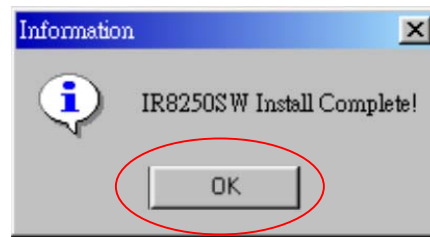
1. Click on **IR8250SW_Setup.exe** to execute InstallShield Wizard.

(**Recommend**) Click **Next** button.



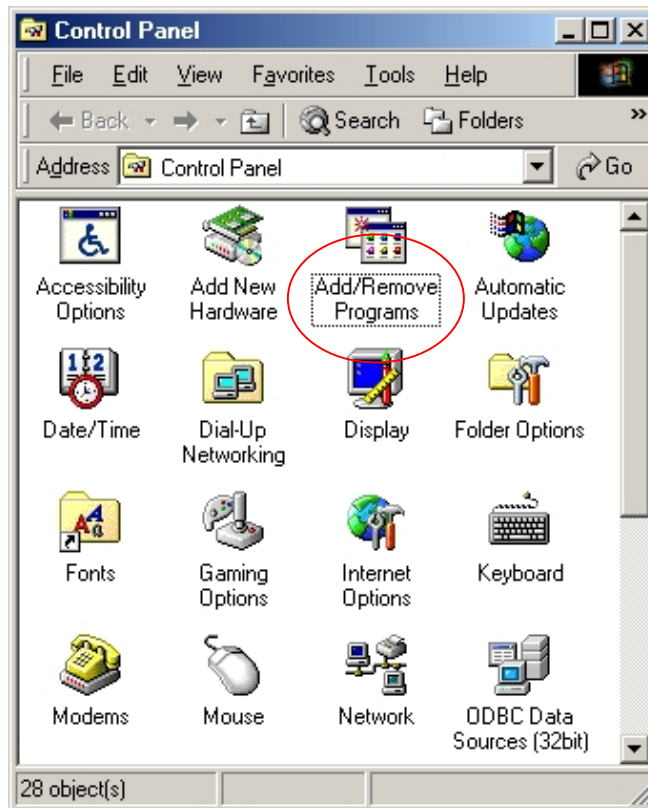

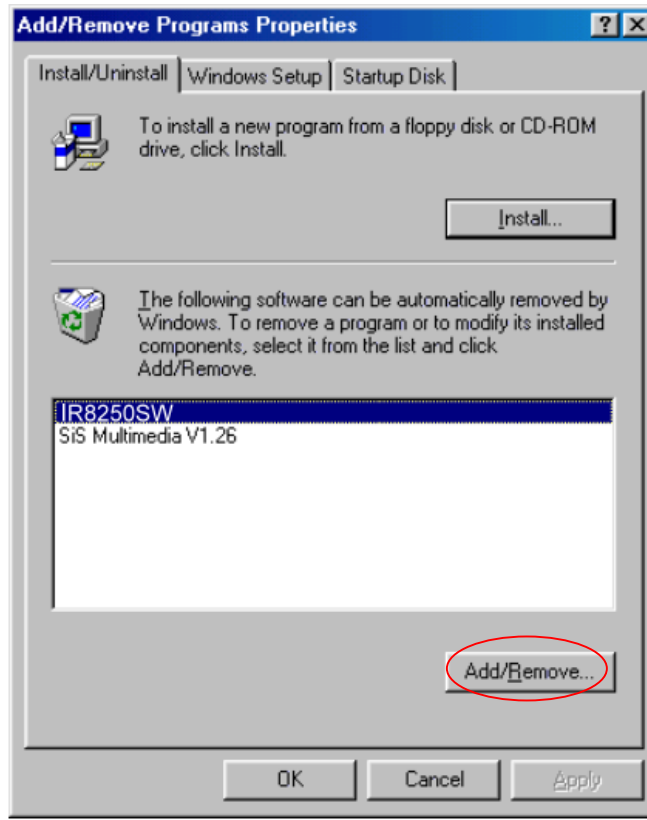
UNINSTALLATION FOR ACT-IR8250SW

Following is the un-installation instruction for ACTiSYS ACT-IR8250SW software under Windows 2000.

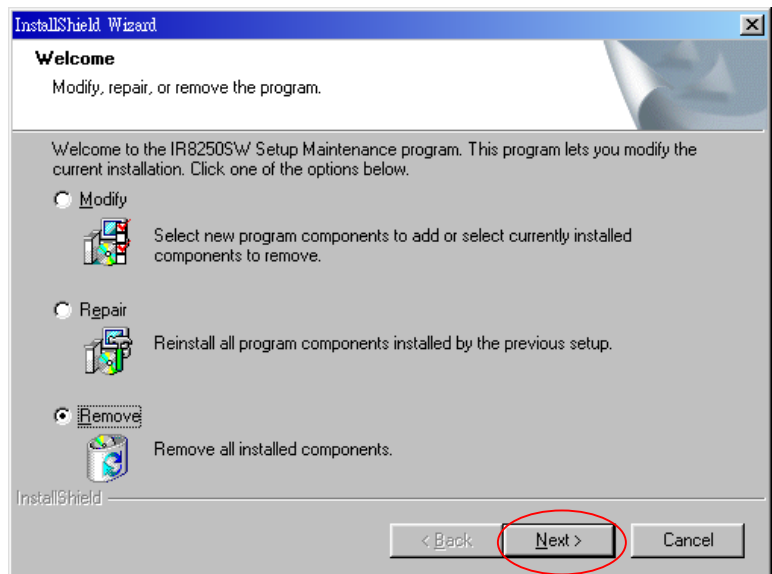
1. Open the **Control Panel** and select **Add/Remove Programs**.



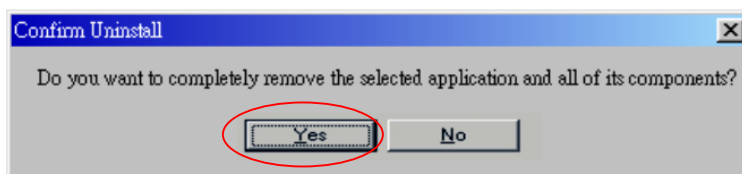
2. Select **IR8250SW** from the list.

3. Select **Remove** and click **Next** button.

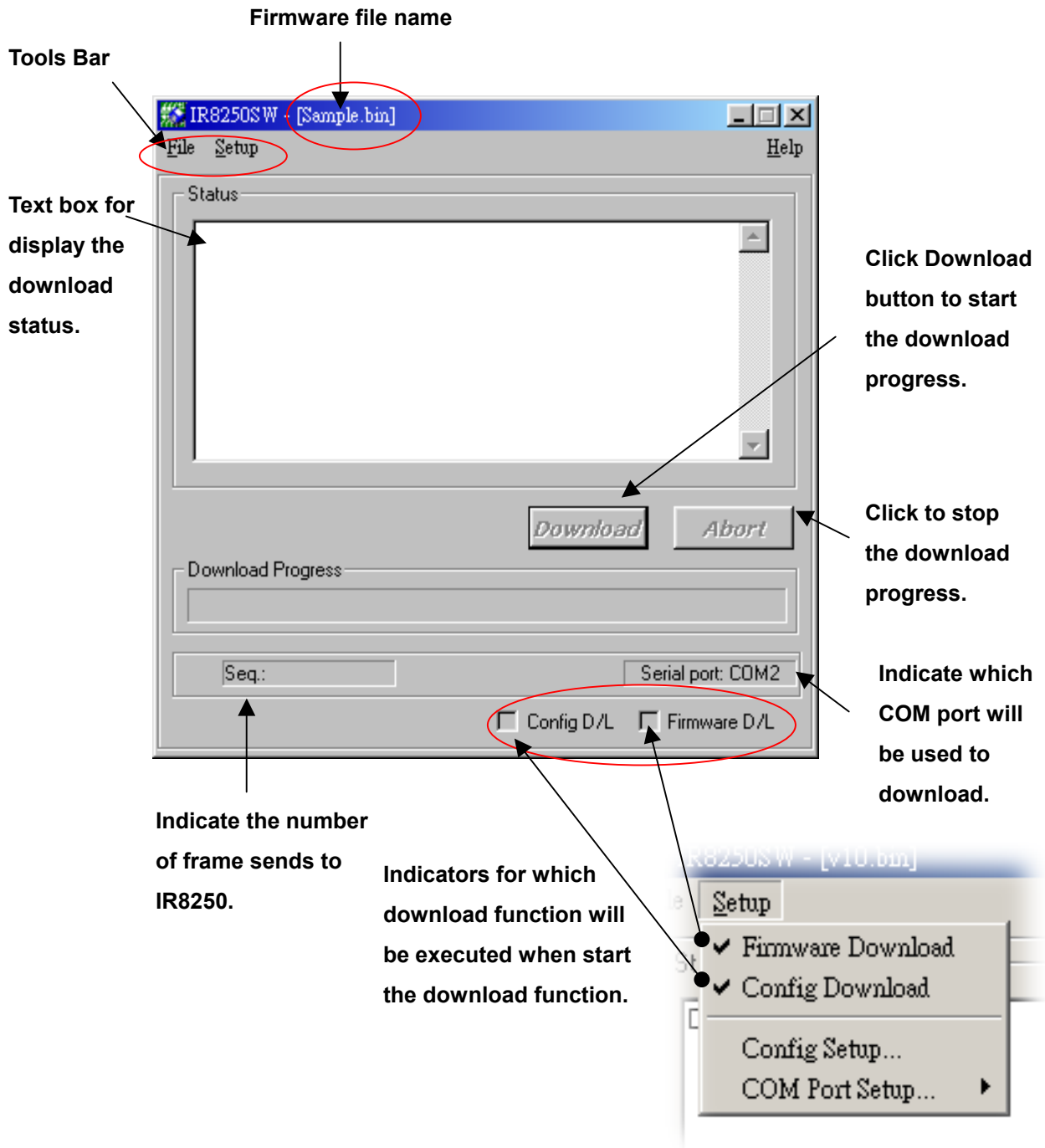


4. Click **Yes** to uninstall the **IR8250SW** software.

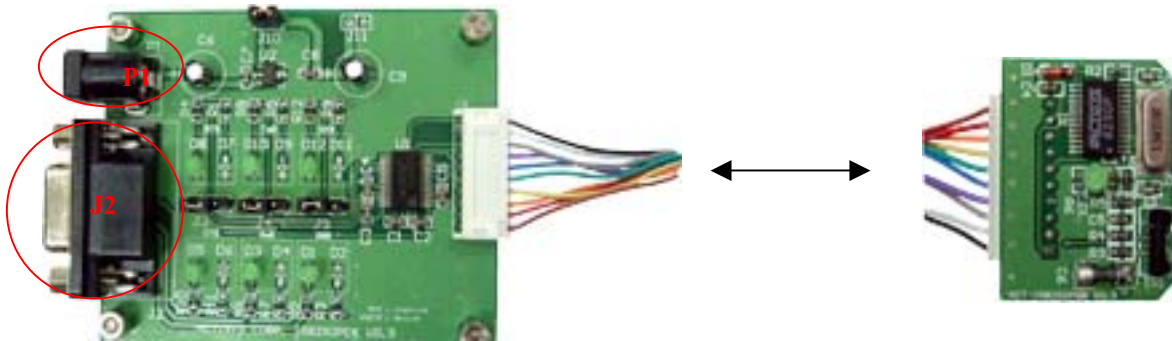

This tutorial illustrates how you may use the IR8250SW to download a firmware and change the config settings.

Before reading this chapter you should:

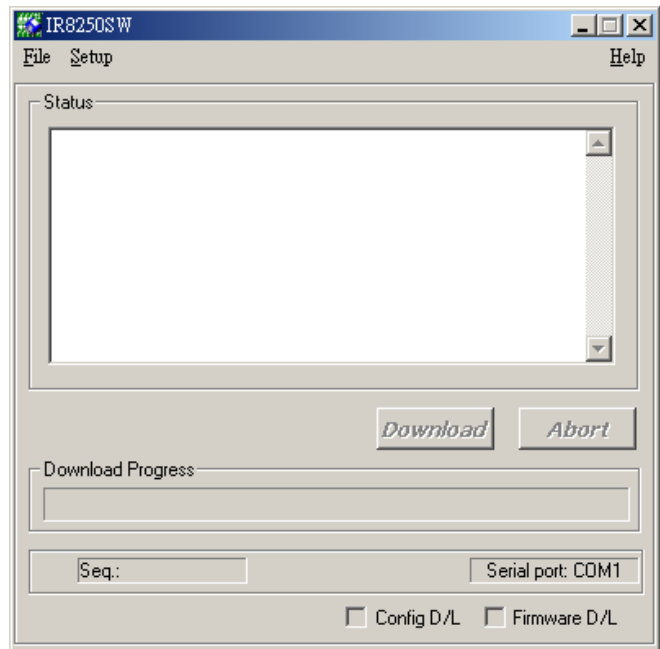
- Have installed the IR8250SW software, as described in the chapter **Installation for ACT-IR8250SW**.
- Setup the *IR8250P evaluation kit*, as described in the IR8250P Specification.
- Make sure that the AC adaptor (P1) and RS-232 cable (J2) has been connected correctly.



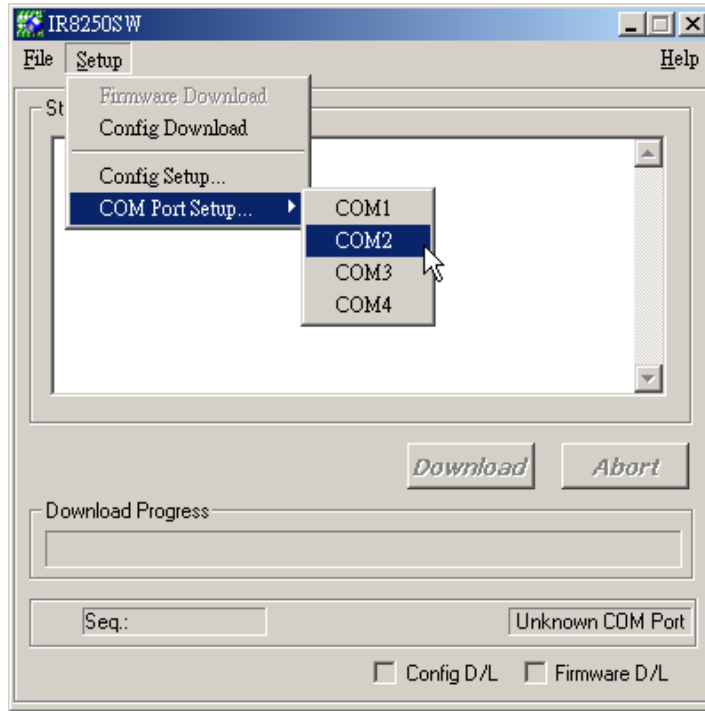
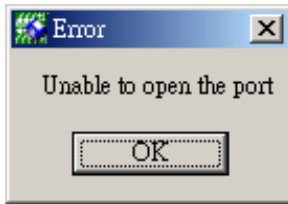
1. Click

Starts→Programs→ACTiSYS→IR8250SW

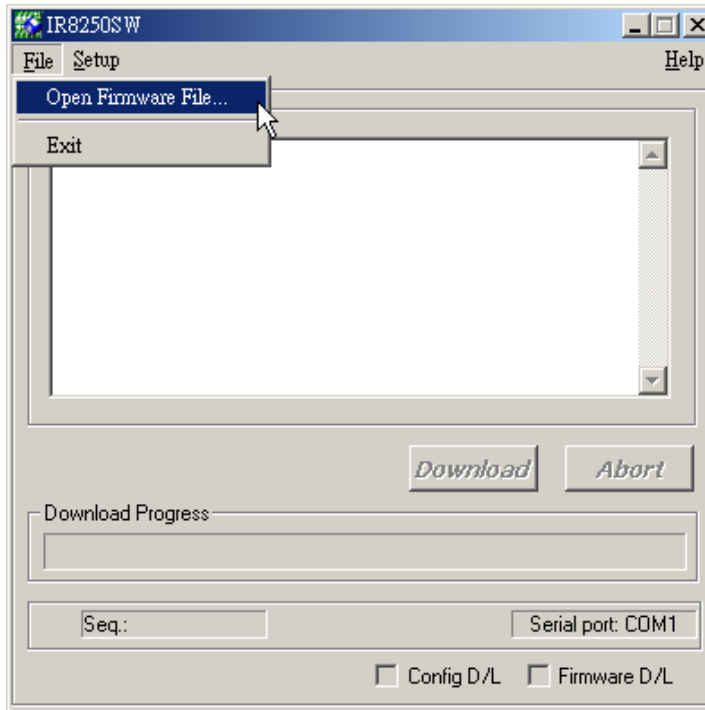

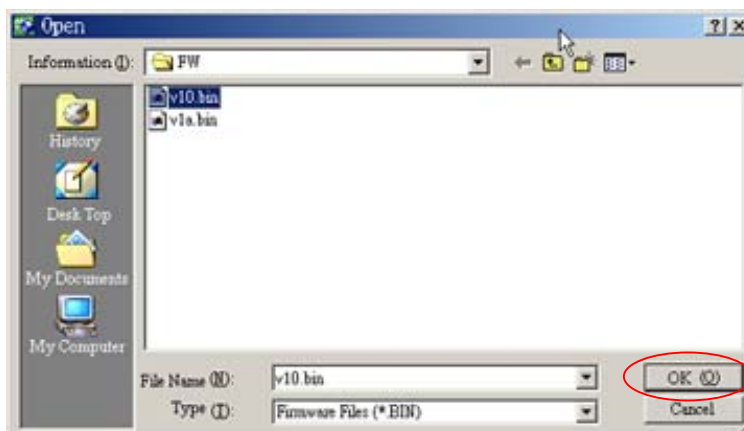
P.S: If an Error message displayed as below, which means the COM port resource has been held for other device. Please select **Setup**→**COM Port Setup** to change COM port.



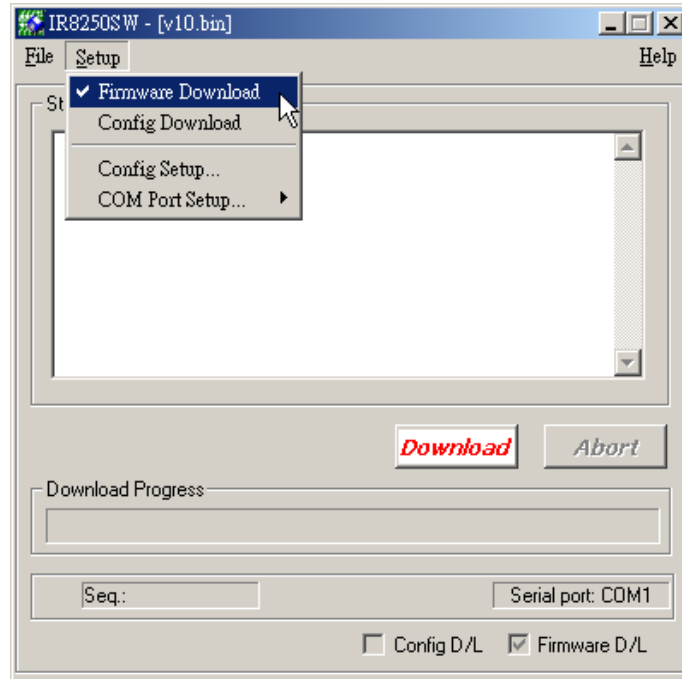
2. Click the **File**→**Open Firmware File** to open the "File Browser Dialog Box".



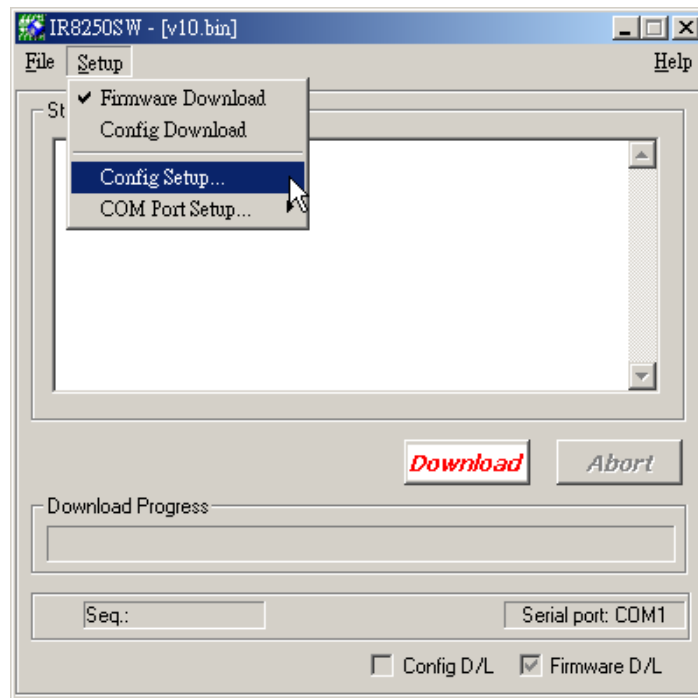
3. Choose the firmware file (*.bin),
click **OK** button to load the
firmware.



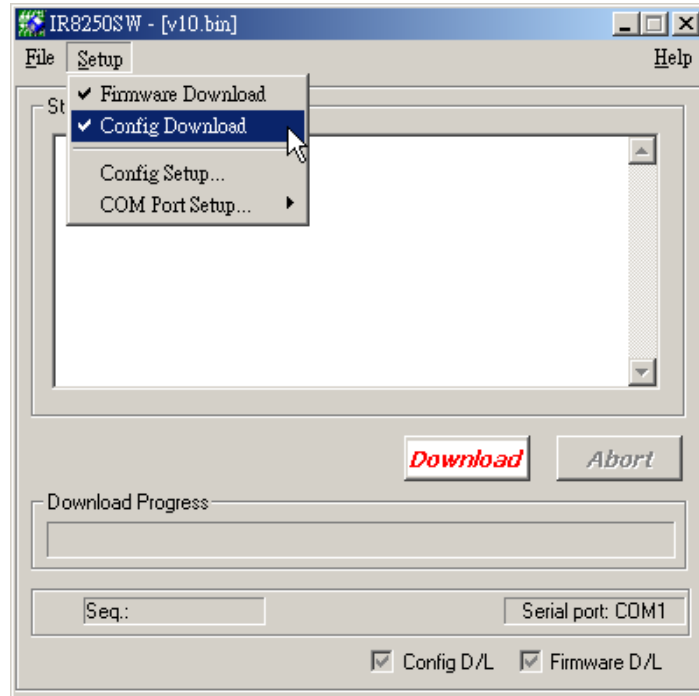
4. Click the **Setup** on the tools bar and Enable **Firmware Download** function.



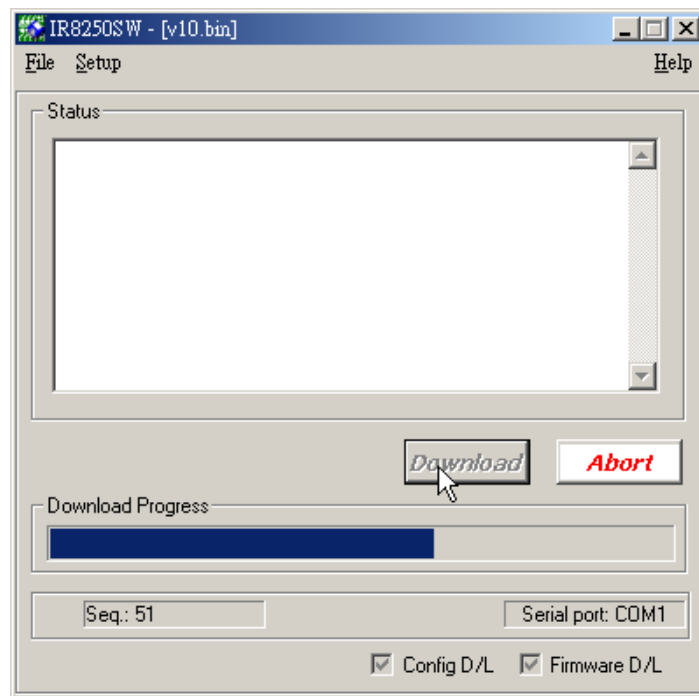
5. Click **Setup**→**Config Setup** (Refer to Page# 10. **Config Setup Window Explain.**) to set the Device name and IR8250 chips information for your application.



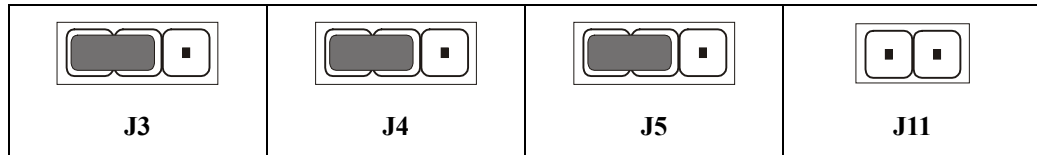
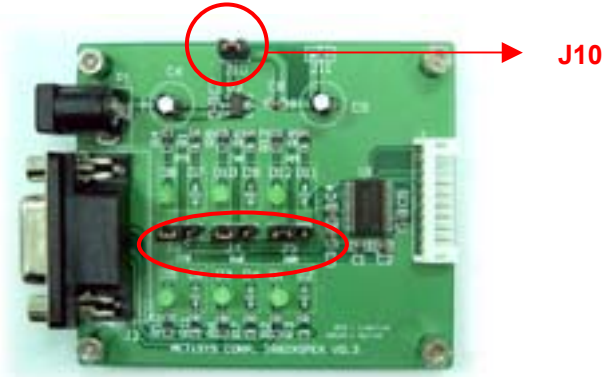
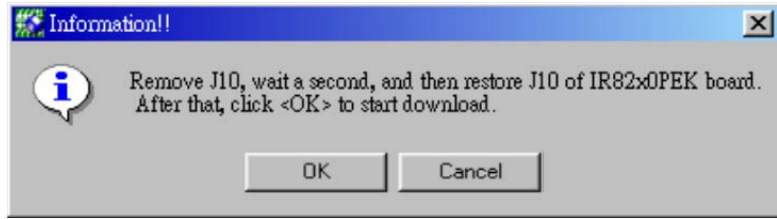
6. Click the **Setup** on the tools bar and Enable **Config Download** function.



7. Click **Download** button to download the **Config setup value** and update firmware to your IR8250 chips



8. Please remove J10, wait a second, and restore J10 of IR82x0PEK board. After that, click **OK** to start download.

9. When you see the “**Download completed!**” message which means you have successfully updated the firmware.



If you do not remove and restore J10 at step 8 correctly, or you click the “Abort” button, or anything to stop the download progress, you will get the Error message shown on the right side.



If this is the case, you will have to check the IR8250SW settings, COM port, AC adaptor, firmware files or IR82x0PEK board. If all right, click the **Download** button again for complete download progress.

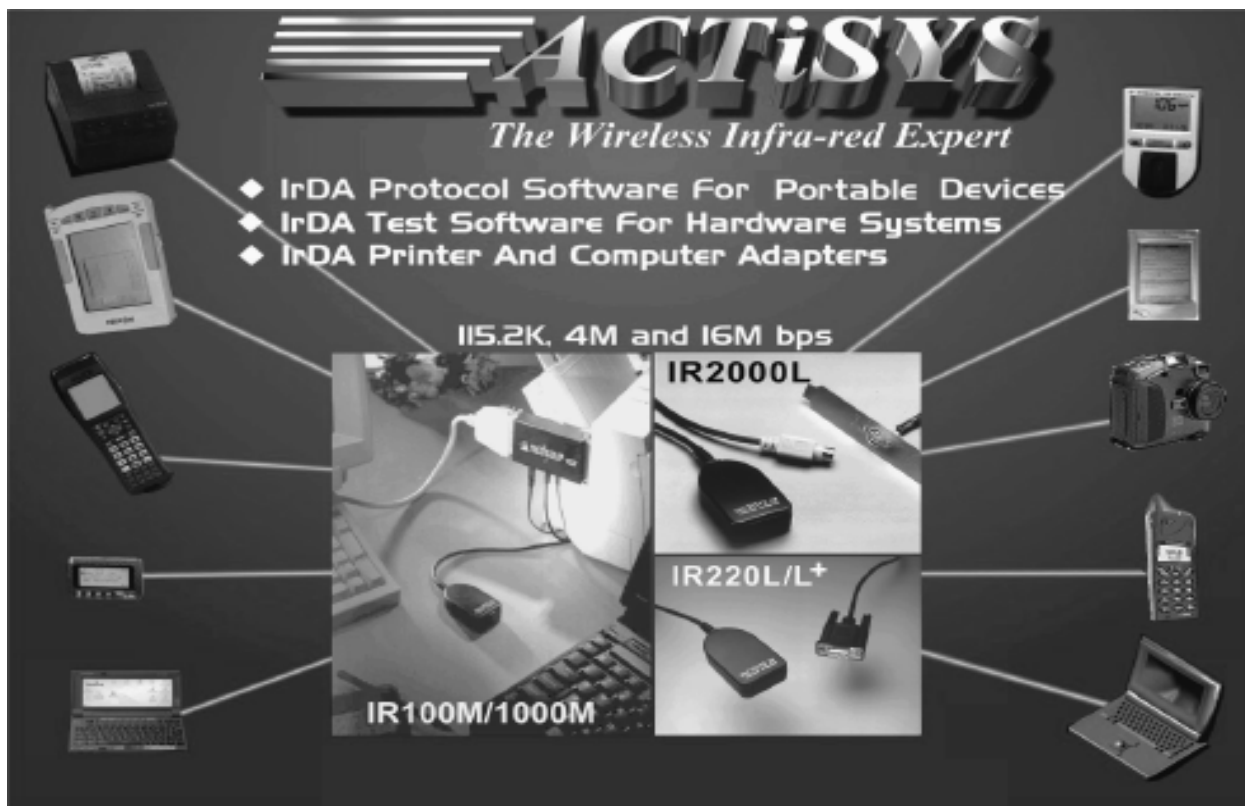
